



Beverly Milder's Musical Arts

Beverly Milder's Musical Arts is one of the largest privately owned music schools in the nation.

“The first time that I saw a Yamaha Music School class, I immediately knew that was what I wanted to do,” said Beverly Milder Magency, the school’s founder. “I was impressed by the method that was used for young children. The parents and students were having fun and learning naturally.”

Magency has a Master’s in music education and thought the Yamaha method was superior to any others. In 1978, she founded Beverly Milder’s Yamaha Music School in her basement.

“Thirty years later, we boast an enrollment of close to 700 weekly students,” Magency said. Magency attributes her school’s success to her staff of 11 teachers, all of whom have music degrees.

“Over the last 30 years, music instruction for young children has become more popular,” Magency said. “I attribute this to advances made in research about the benefits of exposing children to music at a



young age with parental involvement.”

Before taking private lessons, students take classes for two to four years.

“We believe that students need to hear, feel and learn the language of music as a whole,” Magency said.

In addition to class students, *Beverly Milder's Musical Arts* has 300 private students in piano, voice and guitar, with over 10 percent of those students being adults. The school also provides a program for tots ages 2-4 years, which uses rhythms, finger plays, movement, keyboard exploration and singing with a parent or caregiver. The next stage features keyboard and singing classes.

“We are focused on offering music to everyone who wants to enjoy music,” Magency said. “Our primary focus is to give our students the foundation to enjoy music for a lifetime.”
