Cell phone banking will be available for customers who prefer to check balances, transfer funds and pay bills from any location worldwide with mobile phone reception. Traditional Internet banking will be broadened to enable customers to open and manage accounts without the need to travel to the bank.

Customers choosing to come into the new facility will find the traditional stations behind counters have been eliminated and will be given two options for handling their transactions.

“For almost 100 years, the bank has anticipated changing customer prefer-



ences, and our new facility does that with two in-bank choices,” says CEO Michael Walsh.

Personal bankers located at desks will provide all retail banking services, while customers preferring more confidentiality and speed may opt to handle their transactions in a private kiosk where they will work with a teller viewed on a monitor. This new system will make tellers immediately available to customers.

With a family account, children as young as 14 will be given the opportunity to receive a debit card and checking account, after they take a class in financial responsibility at the branch.

The new *Eagle Bank* will be 5,000 square feet with three drive-up lanes and an ATM machine.
