“Bowling is my life,” explained Gary Voss, who has owned *West County Lanes* since 1984 when he and his wife, Pat, took over the business. “I enjoy the sport and have worked in the bowling business all of my adult life, in every phase of the game.”

In 1977, after winning the 1976 Doubles ABC National Championship, Voss purchased Olivette Lanes, his first bowling center. He was one of the top bowlers in the area in the 1960s and 1970s, is in the St. Louis Bowling Hall of Fame, will soon be inducted into the Missouri Bowling Hall of Fame and is executive director of the Bowling Proprietors of Greater St. Louis.

Voss’ family grew up with bowling. His children, Gregg and Lana, attended Texas A&M on bowling scholarships, and Lana was a three-year All American.

As a hands-on owner, Voss personally meets, greets and gets to know his customers.

“We live in this community and are very active in league sponsorships and bringing the sport to Rockwood School Districts’ schools and high school club sports program,” Voss said. “We create fun and competition.”
